

Release 1.5.2-1 (2011-03-01)

This is a maintenance release to fix issues found after the release of 1.5.1

Functional changes

1. A property called `strict.compliance.check = [True|False]` has been added to be used with the `--repackage` option. This property can be set at the project level or used with a build submission. If set to `True`, the results of the mock build are taken into account in setting the build status of a component, otherwise they are only reported for information
2. If a configuration has `package.prefix = /` (directly or by inheritance) the corresponding ETICS-generated spec file does not define `%prefix` anymore to make the RPM non relocatable
3. The special handling of `brp-python-bytecompile` on RH5 and derivatives doesn't require anymore the use of the property

`package.rpm.disable.python-bytecompile`

The ETICS Client automatically adjusts the file list of packages generated by the ETICS Packager to satisfy the `rpm` macro rather than disabling it
