2	BES interface	<p><i>This functionality is not available on the current CREAM CE and is not considered high priority by the developers:</i></p> <p>"Right now we are not focusing too much on this activity because of 2 reasons:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The person in charge of this task (Moreno) is also involved in the ICE activities, which are more important right now - Even if the BES and JSDL specifications are in the final state, they are not suited for production use because they lack significant capabilities. This was also discussed in a inter-operability meeting (called by Laurence Field) that was held at Cern last September. ...it was decided to set a specific OGF working group, called Production Grid Infrastructure (PGI) to define appropriate BES and JSDL profiles including all the important features requested for production use (see http://forge.ogf.org/sf/projects/pgi-wg).
