

AFSLoginProblems login not possible

- Mostly a time setting problem
 - ◆ log in to the host in question, and try *kinit afsuser@CERN.CH* - this should give you more verbose output, e.g.:

```
[root@plus01 etc]# kinit artur@CERN.CH
artur@CERN.CH's Password:
kinit: krb5_get_init_creds: time skew (375) larger than max (300)
```
 - ◆ check time (have your watch synchronised to the CERN time) : *ntpq -p*
 - ◇ you should have at least one time server listed (apart from LOCAL) and synchronised
 - ◇ as an indicator, a jitter value of 4000.00 will tell you that the synchronisation has failed
 - ◆ if time is bad, check the following files (contents to be published soon):
 - ◇ /etc/ntp.conf
 - ◇ /etc/ntp/steptickers
 - ◆ then run system time synchronisation:
 - ◇ */etc/init.d/ntpd stop*
 - ◇ *ntpdate -u time01.daq.lhcb*
 - ◇ *etc/init.d/ntpd start*
 - ◇ *hwclock --systohc* (to synchronise hardware time)
- else check following files (contents to be published soon):
 - ◆ /etc/krb5.conf
 - ◆ /etc/ssh/sshd_config
 - ◆ /usr/vice/etc/ThisCell
