

Enabling password-less access on the Force10 routers

- If not already done, create an RSA2 key for yourself
- Login into the switch as admin
- `copy scp://<login>@10.128.2.2:/home/<login>/.ssh/id_rsa.pub flash://<login>.pub`

I had to type the parameters interactively - maybe a syntax error?

- `ip ssh rsa-authentication my-authorized-keys flash://<login>.pub`
- The Force 10 routers can only contain maximum 5 keys, to clear the old keys:

```
no ip ssh rsa-authentication my-authorized-keys
```

- That's it. You can now login as admin without a password

```
ssh -2 admin@sw-daq-02
```
