- Change the "/system/network/hostname" definition in the quattor template profile\_oldName.tpl
- cp profile\_oldName.tpl profile\_newName.tpl
- Change the template name in the quattor template profile\_oldName.tpl
- update profile\_oldName.tpl and add profile\_newName.tpl
- commit
- On dns-sx-01 :
  - ◆ change the name of the ipmi interface in the dns
  - ◆ change the name of the main interface in the dns
  - ◆ make a dns alias between the old and new names
  - ◆ change dhcp config of the ipmi interface
  - ◆ sudo /usr/sbin/aix-shellfe --remove oldName
  - ◆ sudo /usr/sbin/aix-shellfe --configure newName
  - ◆ sudo /usr/sbin/aix-shellfe --boot newName
  - ◆ It seems that the old name is cache somewhere for these functions : check in dhcpd.conf if the new name replaced the old one. If it's wrong, change by hand.
- on oldName :
  - ◆ modify hostname in /etc/hosts and /etc/sysconfig/network
  - ◆ reboot
- On dns-sx-01 :
  - ◆ remove the alias
  - ◆ change the name of the computer in the dns
