# Class Method

A ClassMethod is a method that must be called relative to the containing class object. This normally only applies to the `new` method used to create new object instances. For example,

# package Telecoms

## ClassMethod new()

```
my $mobile = new Telecoms();
```

or

```
my $mobile = Telecoms->new();
```
