

FORMFIELD{"fieldname"} -- renders a field in the form attached to some topic

- Syntax: %FORMFIELD{"fieldname"}%
- Supported parameters:

Parameter:	Description:	Default:
"fieldname"	The name of a TWiki form field	required
topic="..."	Topic where form data is located. May be of the form <code>Web.TopicName</code>	Current topic
format="..."	Format string. Variable <code>\$value</code> expands to the field value, <code>\$title</code> to the raw field name, <code>\$name</code> to the field name, <code>\$attributes</code> to the attributes, <code>\$type</code> to the form field type, <code>\$size</code> to the size, and <code>\$definingTopic</code> to the form definition topic.	"\$value"
default="..."	Text shown when no value is defined for the field	" "
alttext="..."	Text shown when field is not found in the form	" "
newline="\$br"	Convert newlines in textarea to other delimiters. Variable <code>\$br</code> expands to <code>
</code> tag, and <code>\$n</code> to a newline. Other text is encoded based on <code>encode</code> parameter.	no conversion
encode="html"	Encode special characters into HTML entities. If a FORMFIELD is passed into an HTML form field it should be encoded as "html". Additional encodings available: <code>encode="quote"</code> , <code>encode="moderate"</code> , <code>encode="safe"</code> , <code>encode="entity"</code> and <code>encode="url"</code> . See ENCODE for details.	" " (no encoding)

- Example: %FORMFIELD{"ProjectName" topic="Projects.SushiProject" default="(not set)" alttext="ProjectName field not found"}%
- Example: `<input type="text" name="Address" value="%FORMFIELD{ "Address" encode="html" }%" />`
