1. DAEMONS RUNNING

None. APEL SSM should run as a cron job, once per day.

2. INIT SCRIPTS AND OPTIONS

None. APEL SSM runs as a cron job.

3. CONFIGURATION FILES

The APEL SSM configuration file is located at `/etc/apel/sender.cfg`. This file contains information about SSM's operation, i.e. the name of the destination queue used and the URL of the message broker which the accounting records are sent to.

4. LOG FILES

Logging for the APEL SSM is done in `/var/log/apel/ssmsend.log`.

5. OPEN PORTS

No ports need to be open for incoming connections.

Ephemeral ports must be open for outgoing connections.

6. UNIT TESTING

Not currently available.

7. SERVICE STATE

There is no service state associated with APEL SSM.

8. CRON JOBS

No cron job needs to be scheduled by default.
