

ETICS Scripts

Image creation script (ETICS)

Since SL6 and Debian6 all new machines will have a unique script. In the ASF you have the directory `/afs/cern.ch/project/gd/www/cvi/vmcfg` and there you can find a directory specific for each type of machine.

debian6-64-base (normal)
debian6-64-opt (optimized, with SCSI drivers)
sl6-64-base (normal)
sl6-64-opt (optimized, with SCSI drivers)

In etics we are only using `/afs/cern.ch/project/gd/www/cvi/vmcfg/sl6-64-opt` and `/afs/cern.ch/project/gd/www/cvi/vmcfg/debian6-64-opt` directories. There, like in all other directories, you will find a `vmconfig` file. This file is responsible for the creation of the machines depending on its the name.

If the name of the machine starts with `lxet` the script located in the `etics` directory (`sl6-64-opt/etics` or `debian6-64-opt/etics`) will be executed otherwise the script executed will be the one located in the `tb` directory (`sl6-64-opt/tb` or `debian6-64-opt/tb`).
