Organizational Matters

- We agreed to create a mailing list for convenience, and meet biweekly by video or phone.
- We agreed to create a CERN wiki page for notes of these meetings.
- Patrick Dorn will take minutes, circulate for approval, and post to CERN wiki page.
- Patrick is on vacation - then relocating to Geneva - until the first week in July, so there will be some delay in the posting of initial notes.

Initial discussion on extending ESnet's existing AUP

- Greg explained that ESnet's AUP will need to be revised to accommodate the expanded mission scope envisioned by the EEX project (ie, ESnet will carry LHC for an undefined set of Tier 2 / Tier 3 sites in the US).
- We agreed that revising the AUP is not a 'front burner issue'; the initial build-out is more important at this stage.

Status of EEX planning and activities

- ESnet team recently returned from Terena Networking Conference in Dublin, which included multiple days of in-person negotiation with major European networking partner regarding Scope of Work (SOW) and Terms and Conditions (Ts and Cs) for contract to provide 100G ring and collocation service in Europe.
- Working on 6 subcontracts in parallel.
- On track so far.
